All children will need to have shoes and their polar fleece / sweat shirt on the day.

Each group will be given a plastic gloves on the day and approximately 8 rubbish bags .

We need your support to make this important community event successful.

When we take children off site we require at minimum a ratio of 1 adult to every 8 children to make sure every child is safe **BUT** we would like to have as many parents as possible.
